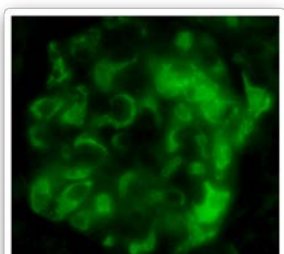
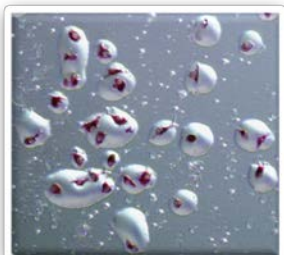
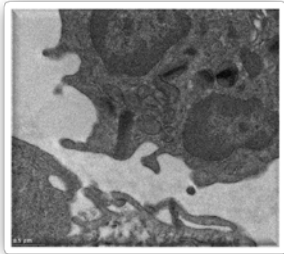
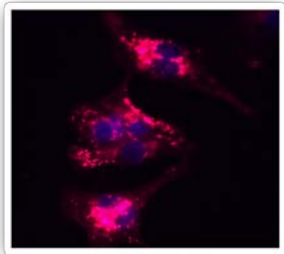


## Postdoctoral position:
