Dear Colleagues,

The International Union of Biochemistry and Molecular Biology (IUBMB) is excited to announce a new vision and editorial team for our flagship journal IUBMB Life, an international peer-reviewed journal in the life sciences. As such, we seek six Associate Editors for the launch of the journal. IUBMB Life is devoted to the rapid publication of the most novel and significant research and reviews in the broadly defined fields of biochemistry, molecular biology, cell biology and molecular medicine. IUBMB Life is a well-established, peer-reviewed, ISI-listed journal that has been in publication since 1990.

The successful candidates should have previous editorial experience and will be appointed for an initial period of 3 years. Terms will commence on January 1st, 2021. Associate Editors' main duties will be: to assign submitted manuscripts to at least two external reviewers, to evaluate reviewers' comments and to make a recommendation to the Editor-in-Chief. As the journal is devoted to rapid publication, it is expected that the entire peer review process to be conducted within 3-4 weeks. The number of articles handled will vary with the areas of expertise per year. Five Associate Editors will be in charge for handling research articles and the sixth for Special Issues and Reviews.

The journal encourages Associate Editors to submit proposals for Special Issues and cutting edge critical reviews as well as to participate in policy making and innovation.

IUBMB will offer an honorarium of 3,000 USD/annum to each Associate Editor in appreciation of their services.

Candidates should submit a short CV (max 3 pages) and a cover letter indicating their previous editorial experience, area expertise, and their vision to Dr Stathis Gonos (sgonos@eie.gr) by **October 31st, 2020**.
